RE: Year 6 SATs

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you know year 6 students must sit the End of Key stage SATs assessments. Mrs. Bi and I would like you to be assured that we are preparing the children for these assessments by using practice questions, papers, running booster groups and teaching extra Maths and English sessions.

From Monday 28th February 2022, we are asking for **all children to be in school by 8.30am at the latest** to provide extra tuition time. This will be until the assessments in May. The year 6 door will be open from 8.25am to allow all children to be settled for the start of the sessions. Please let us know if this is going to be a problem for you.

During the build up to the SATs, we will make sure that the children have opportunities for regular breaks and would advise sending a snack and water bottle every day.

The assessments take place the week beginning 9th May 2022 and the timetable is as follows:

Date	Activity
Monday 9 May 2022	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1 and 2
Tuesday 10 May 2022	English reading
Wednesday 11 May 2022	Mathematics Paper 1 and 2
Thursday 12 May 2022	Mathematics Paper 3



During the assessment week (9th May) all year 6 children are invited to school early to have their breakfast together in the school staff room. This is something that has proved effective in terms of helping them to feel more relaxed and less stressed, as well as ensuring they are all 'well fueled' for the tests they will complete on those days. After the assessments we will ensure that the children have fun and relaxing activities as a reward. More details on this will be sent nearer the time.
