Saltaire workshop- Monday 16th January 2023

Dear Parents/Carers,

This half term, we are learning about the history of Saltaire and are planning on immersing the children in learning through a 'hook' activity and a class visit.

Topic Hook – In school 16th January 2023 for the hook activity, we have arranged for a historian who specialises in Saltaire come into school in costume and character to conduct various talks and presentations. Each child will receive an individual handmade laminated bookmark with the real history of someone who lived and worked in Saltaire on it, from when Titus Salt was in charge. The class gets a set of rules of the village, an up-to-date map showing what the buildings were used for then and are used for now and a sample of Alpaca fibre, which made Titus Salt richer than ever.

The cost of the Historian visit is: £140.85/31 children = £4.55 per child. Please log on to ParentPay for consent/contribution for your child to take part by Friday 13th January.

Towards the end of our topic, we would like to take the children to visit the World Heritage Site of Saltaire on 26th January. Whilst we are there, we will be completing various fieldwork activities and enhancing the learning from our topic. We would like to arrange for as many children as possible to be dropped off and picked up in Saltaire on the day, which will help keep this local visit free of charge and will maximise the time that we can spend in Saltaire. There will be no cost for the Saltaire visit providing we can get most children dropped off and picked up in Saltaire on the day.
