Dear Parent/Carers,

As part of our topic, "Amazing Animals" we will be visiting Tropical World in Leeds on **Tuesday 28**th **February 2023.** During the day, we will have chance to explore the different areas of Tropical world and observe the animals in their habitats. We will also take part in a specially designed workshop. This will enhance our topic work and allow us to use the scientific understanding and vocabulary with real life animals.

<u>Lunch</u>

As children in Reception are in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, the school kitchen can provide a grab bag style packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, bun/flap jack, juice carton) or you can provide your own. On the day, all children will need to bring the following:

- Be dressed in school uniform
- Footwear/Coats appropriate for the weather on the day: waterproofs etc.
- Packed lunch with drink & extra snack **UNLESS** you have pre-ordered a lunch on the link above.

Travel Arrangements will be as follows:

We will be travelling to Tropical World and back by coach. The children will need to be in school at 8:30am for registration as we aim to set off at 08:45am. We anticipate being back in school for 3pm but will keep you up to date and inform you of any changes to travel on the day.

The cost of this trip is £17.76 per child which includes the workshop and transportation. Please see breakdown below:

Cost of workshop and entry to Tropical World: £116.80 Cost of Transport: £345.00

Total cost of trip: £461.80 divided by 26 Children = £17.76 per child

Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and click on 'other items' the "Tropical World" trip will be listed. **Consent & Contribution deadline is: Monday 20th February 2023** Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead.
