Dear Parent/Carer

I am very excited to tell you about our upcoming trip to Cliff Castle in Keighley which will take place on **Thursday 3rd November 2022**. This trip will be a 'hook' for our history topic, The Stone Age through to the Iron Age.

To start our day, we will take part in a workshop where pupils will get hands on with real Stone Age artefacts and use archaeological techniques – including digging and recording, to discover how people from the Stone Age and Bronze Age interacted with the land around them. The children will then get the chance to look around the museum and grounds of Cliff Castle.

All children will need to bring the following:

- Packed Lunch with a drink & a healthy snack
- Footwear/Coats appropriate for the weather on the day: waterproofs/hat
- Children will need to be in their school uniform.

Travel Arrangements will be as follows:

We will travel there and back by minibus. Please **arrive at school for 08:30am** prompt, as we will be setting off from school at 08:45am. The children will return to school and will have their usual pick-up time of 3pm.

The cost of this trip will be **£4.42** per child (Please see breakdown below)

- Stone Age workshop £96.00
- Travel Via Minibus £36.75
- Total trip cost= £132.75
£132.75 Divided by 30 children = **£4.42 per child**

Consent and contribution are via ParentPay. Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and click on 'other items', the Cliff Castle trip will be listed. Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Consent/contribution deadline is **Thursday 20th October 2022**.
