As part of our topic, 'Ticket to Ride', Reception will be visiting the Worth Valley Railway at Ingrow on **Wednesday 21st June 2023**. During the day, we will visit the two museums; The Engine Shed and The Carriage Works exploring the history of transport. We will also take a ride on a steam train from Ingrow to Keighley and back having a teddy bears picnic and our lunch in the carriages. We will also take part in a specially designed workshop.

Lunch

As children in Reception are in receipt of Universal Free School Meals, the school kitchen can provide a grab bag style packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, bun/flap jack, juice carton) or you can provide your own. On the day, all children will need to bring the following:

- Be dressed in school uniform
- Footwear/Coats appropriate for the weather on the day: waterproofs etc.
- Packed lunch with drink & extra snack **UNLESS** you have pre-ordered a lunch on the link above.

Travel Arrangements will be as follows:

We will be travelling to Ingrow Train station and back by minibus. Our trip is during school time therefore drop off and pick up times are **not** affected.

The cost of this trip is **£12.69** per child which includes the workshop, train fares and transportation/fuel. Total trip cost £330.00 divided by 26 children = £12.69

Consent and contribution are via ParentPay. Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and click on 'other items' the Worth Valley Railway trip will be listed. **Consent & Contribution deadline is Monday 12th June 2023**. Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead.
