Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Bradford Literature Festival, 'Who Was Tutankhamun?' – Monday 26th June 2023

We have planned to take the children in Year 3 and 4 on a visit to the University of Bradford to take part in a workshop about Tutankhamun. This trip will act as a hook for Year 3, ready for their Ancient Egypt topic in Year 4, and a great opportunity for the Year 4 children to revisit and consolidate previous learning.

We will travel there and back by train and would ask that all children are dropped off at **Bingley train station at 07:40am** as the train departs at 8:00am. Once arriving in Bradford, we will then walk to the University of Bradford which will take approximately 15 minutes. The whole day is run by the Bradford Literature Trust where academics and Egyptologists will lead a day-long journey of life at the time of Tutankhamun from the art of mummification to meeting a real-life Indiana Jones. We will then get a train back to Bingley at 15:11 and arrive at the train station for collection at approximately 15:25.

Please can you send your child to school with a **packed lunch, extra snack and a drink.**
