RE: Bradford Literature Festival, Kashmir Uncovered– Tuesday 20th June 2023

We have planned to take the children in Year 5 on a visit to the University of Bradford to take part in a workshop about Kashmir. The beautiful Kashmir valley, known as the Switzerland of the East, is home to stunning mountain ranges including Nanga Parbat – the ninth highest and most dangerous mountain on earth. This fascinating exploration of Kashmir from ages past into the modern day will give insight into the lives of the people of Kashmir, their history and incredible geography. Kashmiri culture will be celebrated in interactive sessions of music, dance and historic handicrafts.

We will travel there and back by train and would ask that all children are dropped off at **Bingley train station at 07:40am** as the train departs at 08:00am. Once arriving in Bradford, we will then walk to the University of Bradford which will take approximately 20 minutes. We will then get a train back to Bingley at 15:10 and arrive at the train station for collection at approximately 15:25.

Please can you send your child on this day with a **packed lunch, extra snack and a drink.**
