Curriculum Information Year 3 Spring 2024



We are very excited to get busy learning in the Spring term in Year 3, there are lots of exciting things happening this term. On the 16th of January we will be going to Stump Cross Caverns to support our geography and science learning.

PE will be on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, so please come in kit and trainers on this day.

We will be able to switch books in the library on a Friday. Reading books are swapped throughout the week, please ensure these are in school everyday, after going home each night to allow daily reading.

English

Spellings

Weekly spelling lists will be assigned on spelling shed, the spelling rule will be taught once they are assigned. These are also on Marvellous Me. We will now be moving on to more complex rules in our spelling sessions.

Text Types

We will be starting by studying fantasy stories, followed by explanations, reports and further poetry. We aim to use a variety of text types to inspire this learning such as fictional books, non-fiction reports, short films and more to expose the class to a wide range.

Maths

Multiplication & Division

We will be continuing our unit of multiplication and division. Covering multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8. Recapping multiples of 2, alongside the above times tables. This will be enriched with reasoning and problem solving questions.

Length & Perimeter

This unit will focus on measuring length, and finding the perimeter. Using centimetres and millimetres, finding equivalent lengths and completing related calculations.

Fractions

This unit will build understanding of numerators and denominators, being able to order, compare and count in fractions.

Mass & Capacity

We will focus on using scales, using the grams and kilograms to determine mass, finding the equivalent and comparing these. Determining capacity and volume by using millilitres. Also adding and subtracting these in calculations.

Alongside these units we will continually practice times tables through the use of TT Rockstars.

Reading

In class we will be reading multiple whole class stories, we read a small amount each day.

We also have book club on a Friday afternoon, to allow positive discussion and sharing of books. In this time we also upload reviews onto our class iPad.

History-Spring 2

What was life like in the Tudor times?

A workshop will be held in school to support this learning. We will be using resources to investigate what life was like and asking questions to further our understanding of the time period.

Art-Spring 1

<u>Painting</u>— What was the Pop Art movement?

Our focus artist will be Andy Warhol and other influential members of the Pop Art movement. We will work towards creating a pop art inspired layered portrait.
