Maths

Revision

English

We will continue to use Spelling Shed to practise and consolidate our spelling of current and previous spelling rules. Spellings will be tested on Monday.

Science

Evolution and Inheritance

- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Maps

MFL (Spanish)

In MFL lessons this term, we will continue to use Language Nut.

- Learn vocabulary to help them get about town.
- Learn about the different cultures in the city of Barcelona.
- Revisit the imperative form of the verb whilst giving directions.

- To develop teamwork through a variety of challenges.
- To work individually, collaboratively in pairs and groups to solve problems and share ideas to create strategies and plans to produce the best solution to a challenge.
- To lead groups and utilise negotiation skills.

ATHLETICS

- To develop sprinting, throwing and jumping techniques.

Music

After listening to and appraising the theme from Chariots of Fire by Vangelis , the class will create music to accompany a short film about a race, composing an extended melody and accompaniment.

Exploring identity through song

The pupils will explore how songwriters use personal experiences as a starting point for exploring themes around identity, as well as aspects of lyric writing and expressive singing to convey mood and emotion.

RE

This unit focuses on this personal quest, starting with an exploration of the responsibilities and opportunities that arise as young people grow into adulthood. It investigates religious and secular responses to growing up, including rites of passage. As part of the study, pupils consider their own values, beliefs and commitments.

Homework

Homework Club will recommence on Monday 8th until Monday 29th April. Pages from each of the Rising Stars books will be set on Monday to be returned for marking in class on the following Monday; the page numbers will be posted on Marvellous Me.

Reading - Children are expected to read at home for 10 minutes at least 4 times a week and record this in their reading journals. We would really appreciate it if you could make sure your child's reading book and reading journal are in school every day. Books will be changed when required.

Spelling - The children have become confident with Spelling Shed, and this will continue, with spelling tests being carried out on a Monday.

Maths - The children have their TT Rockstars login and are encouraged to access this regularly at home to become fluent with their timetables.
