Dear Parents/Carers

We are very excited to share with you our new EYFS outdoor provision and KS1 playground apparatus project. We have worked together with Exceed Trust and the School Council to design our new playground equipment and provision. The works for this will start this coming Monday 20th June. The area will be cordoned off with appropriate fencing (by the contractors) around the affected areas to enable the work to take place. This project will have minimal impact to the children and will be an amazing opportunity for the children to see the work progress and see their design come to life.

From this Monday access to the Year 1 and Reception classrooms will change. Reception and Year 1 will enter via the side entrance to the school between the hall door and Year 4 door (under the canopy). The Reception and Year 1 class teachers will be stood in the playground ready to direct the children to the correct entrance and the children will be shown this entrance on Friday to avoid any disruption. Reception's coat and bag pegs will all be put inside the building in a temporary area.

The Reception outdoor provision will be set up in the outdoor wooden classroom, and they will have carefully planned activities in the playground throughout the day to ensure they have full access to all of their usual exciting opportunities.

The work is expected to last 3 weeks and we are very excited for you to see the finished outcome.
