Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Lotherton Hall – Friday 24th June 2022

I have planned to take Year 4 on a visit to Lotherton Hall to enhance our work on World War II. This trip will enable your child to experience a unique insight into the life as an evacuee in the Second World War. It will also provide a variety of opportunities for follow up work back in school upon our return.

We will travel there and back by a coach. We will be setting off at 8:45am prompt so I would appreciate it if your child could be lined up in the playground at **8:30am**. We will attend a workshop and take part in a range of activities linked to evacuees. In the afternoon we will explore the grounds of Lotherton Hall and the wildlife world. We will then leave Lotherton Hall at 13:50, arriving back at school for around 3pm. Your child will need a **packed lunch and drink**.

The day is designed for the children to dress in the style of a child who is about to be evacuated therefore please can you support your child to come dressed in this style, I have attached some pictures to help.

The cost of this trip is **£20.52** per child (see breakdown below)

- Museum Entry & Workshop/s £106
 - Transport Costs £530
- Total Costs: £636
- Divided by 31 children = **£20.52 per child**

Payment/consent is via ParentPay. Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and click on 'other items' and the Lotherton Hall trip will be listed. Contributions are voluntary, however, should insufficient contributions be received, the trip will not be able to go ahead. Consent/contribution deadline is Friday 17th June 2022.
