Dear Parents

As a school we will be returning to Ingleborough Hall, again this academic year with our current Year 6 class for their 3-day residential.

The school feels that this residential will offer our children unique opportunities and will enable the children and staff to end their time at Harden Primary School on a fun-filled, positive note. Ingleborough Hall offers a variety of activities including Caving, Climbing, Gorge Scrambling, Walking, Games and Camp Fires. The 'hall' employs qualified instructors who are supported by our school staff and Ingleborough Hall standards of safety are very high.

The date of the residential is now confirmed as Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 and the cost of is **£165.55 per child**. This cost includes travel, food, accommodation and activities.

For your information, the breakdown of costs for this residential are indicated below:

Total Venue costs*	£4231.50
Transportation costs**	£540.50
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	£4,772.00 divided by 29 children = <b>£165.55</b>

Please secure your child place by making a deposit of **£35.55** via ParentPay by 30<sup>th</sup> November. You will then be able to 'chip away' at the remaining balance of £130.00 over the next 8 months up to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

Please log on to your child's ParentPay account and under their name, click on 'pay for other item's the 2 payment items will be listed as 'Ingleborough Deposit' and 'Ingleborough Remaining Balance'.

The school appreciates that not all children wish to go on a residential therefore if your child is apprehensive about attending, please speak to myself or Mrs. Connor in the office.
